W. C. Steinhagen Award
Criteria

This award will honor those Lions who have been outstanding in using their time, talents and efforts in promoting humanitarian service in their communities.

Selection shall be by committee. The committee of 5 members, each from a different club shall be appointed by the District Governor. The nominees and their information will be presented to the District Governor at the District Mid-Winter Conference. This information will be presented to the 5 member committee and they will provide their recommendation to the District Governor no later than March 31st. The nominations will be from all over the district and the district will award 4 awards per year. One from each zone. The awards will be presented by the District Governor at the District Convention.

Minimum standards to qualify for the District Grassroot Lion Award are:

- a. Be an active member with at least three (3) years of service;
- b. Having shown a high level of ethical practice;
- c. Having provided outstanding and dedicated service as a Lion beyond the call of duty;
- d. Having provided other than service as a Lion to their community and district.
- e. Having accomplished special achievements in, or contributions to, humanitarian service for those less fortunate.
